Polysal paint protectant applied at regular intervals, beige leather seats in excellent condition

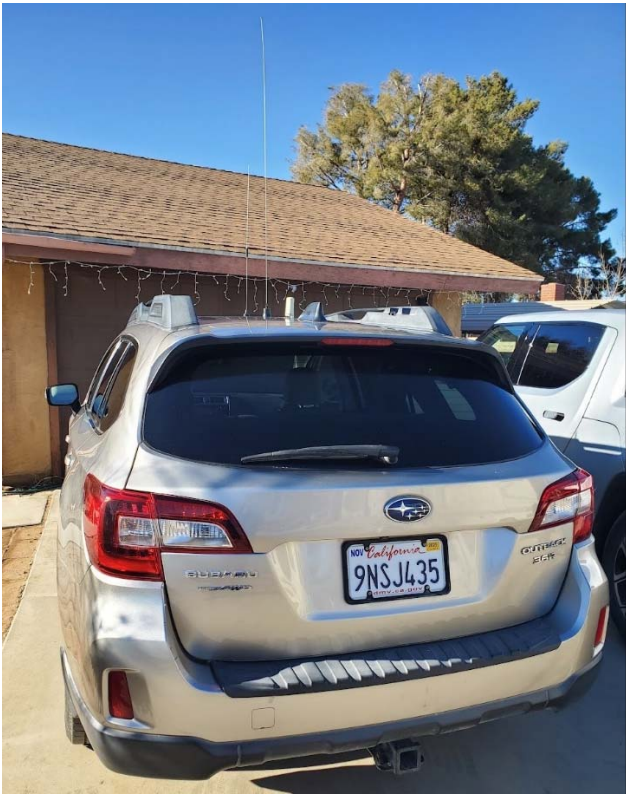
Kept under a car port, complete service records, **\$10,500 firm**

### Accessories:

- 2" receiver with the flat 4 pin trailer power connector, easily tows 3,000 lbs.
- Three permanent NMO roof mounted antenna connectors:
  - Includes a dedicated 2 meter antenna (VSWR can be tuned)
  - Includes a dedicated 440 antenna (VSWR can be tuned)
  - Includes duplexer for combining the 2m and 440 cables
  - Laird 4G cell antenna and cable for a cell repeater (repeater is included but needs work).
- Both under hood and inside cabin 12v power cables with power pole connectors for ham radio use.
- Dash cover and windshield shade screens
- Deer whistles



#### **Recent Service:**

- New windshield (Jan 2025)
- New battery (Dec 2024)
- Replaced both rear wheel bearings and brake pads, and rear rotors were turned (Aug 2024)
- Replaced the spark plugs and serpentine belt (April 2024)
- Replaced tires with Michelin Defenders (80k mile warranty) at 116,000 miles (Dec 2022)

#### **Negatives:**

- The front passenger window can't be raised or lowered from the driver's control (works fine from the passenger's control).
- The dash indicator incorrectly indicates there is a low tire (maybe a sensor problem?)

#### **Why are we selling it?**

We used the Outback for around town driving, road trips and working ham radio events. We recently purchased a Rivian R1T that meets our needs for all these requirements, so it is time to sell the Outback. We would prefer to sell it to a ham who can make use of the dedicated antenna system.
